

## After Hours Care

### Extended After Hours—Weekends

Our **office phone lines** are open from **8:30 am until 12 pm**. We will see children with acute illnesses or minor trauma between **9:00-12:00 pm**. We prefer that you call ahead but walk-ins are accepted. Well visits are scheduled **only** during weekdays.

### Extended After Hours—Evenings

We are open **5:00 pm until 8:00 pm** to accommodate patients with acute illnesses or minor trauma. These **acute evening visits** are scheduled on the **same day only**. We do schedule a limited number of well visits in the evening.

### After Hours Coverage

Our practice uses the Rochester Community Triage System for after hours calls. Nurses, with specialized training in providing pediatric medical advice, answer the calls. The phone number to call is **(585) 225-2525**. A pediatrician from our office is available **24 hours** a day for backup to this nurse and will return calls, when appropriate.

### Holidays

Our triage system will be available by calling **(585) 225-2525**; and a pediatrician is **always on call**. We will be closed on the following days only: Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years Day.

### Emergencies

In the event of a **life-threatening emergency** (e.g. choking and severe breathing problem) **call 9-1-1**. Please call us after to let us know and obtain a referral

from your insurance company. For **minor injuries**, we can frequently provide you with first aid instructions by phone, and decide if your child needs to be seen in our office or in the emergency room. If your child has a **cut**, we can **suture, glue or tape** the cut in our office. If your child does need to go to the Emergency Room, we will generally refer you to either Golisano Children's Hospital at Strong or Rochester General Hospital who are staffed with pediatricians and other support services.

### Prescription Refills and Forms

Although we will make every effort to refill prescriptions requests as soon as possible, we ask that you call us at least **five days** before you run out of medication. We will complete any forms mailed to us and return them quickly but request that you include a stamped, self-addressed envelope or instructions on picking them up or to whom they should be faxed.  
**\*NB: co-pays are expected at the time of the visit.**

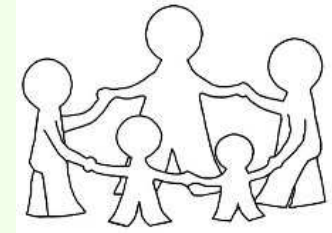

## Our Policies and Procedures:

### Weekdays

Our pediatricians are on staff at all four area hospitals including the Golisano Children's Hospital at Strong. Our pediatricians will visit all newborns within **24 hours** of delivery at all four birthing centers. Children and adolescents who need admissions will be referred to either Golisano Children's Hospital at Strong or Rochester General Hospital. For the benefit of all our patients, we do schedule visits by **appointment**. Please call us if you know you will be delayed or cannot keep your appointment. **Scheduled visit** appointment times are Monday-Friday **8:40 am to 5:00 pm.. We offer extended after hours from 5pm to 8pm Monday-Friday, and 8:30am to 12 pm on Saturday & Sunday.**

### Prenatal Visits

Prenatal visits can be arranged by calling our office. You will be able to meet one of our pediatricians and plan your future baby's care. **Open House Visits** are available weekly for new patients; please call ahead for times.

### Annual Well Child Visits

Please book your child's annual visit in your child's **Birth month**, or as close to it as possible. We require an **annual exam for every patient**. School, camp and daycare **forms** require a recent exam. **Pre-operative forms** require an exam within 30 days of the surgery.
